

PREDOCTORAL RESEARCH AWARD



The *Dígitos* journal, published by the University of Valencia in Spain, will award a predoctoral research prize for the best article published in any section (“Monographic” or “Open Zone”) of its tenth issue.

Requirements for applicants

Be a master’s or PhD student.

Academic requirements

The article must follow the [journal’s publication guidelines](#) and address a topic dealing with communication and online culture.

Deadline for submitting articles

Articles considered for the prize and publication will be submitted through the [journal’s online platform](#) no later than 23:59 (GMT+2) on **22nd December 2023**. They will have to **indicate their interest** to be considered in the contest in the note to the editor.

Award

The research prize consists of the public presentation of the paper at a conference organised by the University of Valencia in the academic year 2024-2025, associated with a bonus of €150 and the publication of the article in the 10th issue of *Dígitos*. The journal will cover the cost of the winner's transport and accommodation for the conference, up to a limit of €200.

Selection committee

The selection committee will consist of the journal’s editor-in-chief and four other members of the editorial department of *Dígitos*. The results will be announced on 15th June 2024 on the journal’s website and through its social media accounts.
