

**PREDOCTORAL RESEARCH AWARD**

The *Revista Dígitos* journal, published by the University of Valencia in Spain, will award a predoctoral research prize for best article published in any section (“Monographic” or “Open Zone”) of its sixth issue.

**Requirements for applicants**

Be a master’s or PhD student.

**Academic requirements**

The article must follow the [journal’s publication guidelines](#) and address a topic dealing with communication and online culture.

**Deadline for submitting articles**

Articles considered for the prize and publication will be submitted through the [journal’s online platform](#) no later than 23:59 (GMT+2) on **November 15, 2019**. They will have to indicate their interest to be considered in the contest in the note to the editor.

**Award**

The author of the winning article, which will be published in issue 6 of *Dígitos*, will present his or her research publicly at a conference that will take place at the University of Valencia during 2019-2020 course. The research prize is 350€, for the researcher’s transport and lodging, in addition to 150€ as consideration for his or her participation in the conference.

**Selection committee**

The selection committee will consist of the journal’s editor in chief and the deputy editor, in addition to three other members of the editorial department of *Revista Dígitos*. The results will be announced on November 22 on the journal’s website and through its social media accounts.
