

PREDOCTORAL RESEARCH AWARD



The *Dígitos* journal, published by the University of Valencia in Spain, will award a predoctoral research prize for best article published in any section (“Monographic” or “Open Zone”) of its seventh issue.

Requirements for applicants

Be a master’s or PhD student.

Academic requirements

The article must follow the [journal’s publication guidelines](#) and address a topic dealing with communication and online culture.

Deadline for submitting articles

Articles considered for the prize and publication will be submitted through the [journal’s online platform](#) no later than 23:59 (GMT+2) on **November 15, 2020**. They will have to indicate their interest to be considered in the contest in the note to the editor.

Award

The research award consists of a gratification of € 150 and the publication of the article in issue 7 of the *Dígitos* journal, stating that it is an award-winning research. If the person responsible for the awarded research so wishes, this work can also be publicly presented at the University of Valencia in the academic year 2020-2021. In this case, in addition to the € 150 bonus, the *Dígitos* journal will cover the cost of the researcher's transportation and accommodation.

Selection committee

The selection committee will consist of the journal’s editor in chief and the deputy editor, in addition to three other members of the editorial department of *Dígitos*. The results will be announced on November 22 on the journal’s website and through its social media accounts.
