

## PREDOCTORAL RESEARCH AWARD



The *Dígitos* journal, published by the University of Valencia in Spain, will award a predoctoral research prize for best article published in any section (“Monographic” or “Open Zone”) of its eighth issue.

### Requirements for applicants

Be a master’s or PhD student.

### Academic requirements

The article must follow the [journal’s publication guidelines](#) and address a topic dealing with communication and online culture.

### Deadline for submitting articles

Articles considered for the prize and publication will be submitted through the [journal’s online platform](#) no later than 23:59 (GMT+2) on **November 15, 2021**. They will have to indicate their interest to be considered in the contest in the note to the editor.

### Award

The research award consists of a gratification of € 150 and the publication of the article in issue 8 of the *Dígitos* journal, stating that it is an award-winning research. If the person responsible for the awarded research so wishes, this work can also be publicly presented at the University of Valencia in the academic year 2021-2022. In this case, in addition to the € 150 bonus, the *Dígitos* journal will cover the cost of the researcher's transportation and accommodation.

### Selection committee

The selection committee will consist of the journal’s editor in chief and the deputy editor, in addition to five other members of the editorial department of *Dígitos*. The results will be announced on November 30 on the journal’s website and through its social media accounts.
