



PREDOCTORAL RESEARCH AWARD

The *Dígitos* journal, published by the University of Valencia in Spain, will award a predoctoral research prize for the best article published in any section ("Monographic" or "Open Zone") of its ninth issue.

Requirements for applicants

Be a master's or PhD student.

Academic requirements

The article must follow the journal's publication guidelines and address a topic dealing with communication and online culture.

Deadline for submitting articles

Articles considered for the prize and publication will be submitted through the journal's online platform no later than 23:59 (GMT+2) on **23rd December 2022**. They will have to **indicate their interest** to be considered in the contest in the note to the editor.

Award

The research prize consists of the public presentation of the paper at a conference organised by the University of Valencia in the academic year 2022-2023, associated with a bonus of \in 150 and the publication of the article in the 9th issue of Dígitos. The journal will cover the cost of the winner's transport and accommodation for the conference, up to a limit of \in 200.

Selection committee

The selection committee will consist of the journal's editor-in-chief and four other members of the editorial department of Digitos. The results will be announced on 15th February 2023 on the journal's website and through its social media accounts.
